


There have been 319 Science-Based Nobel Prizes awarded to Americans from 1901-2023. 115, or 36% of those winners were immigrants.




#### **U.S. Graduate Students**

Percentage of US-based Graduate Students by Field








## **US-based Immigrant Entrepreneurs in AI**


There are currently 43 US-based AI companies valued over \$1 Billion (Unicorns). Of those 43...

65% were founded or co-founded by an immigrant




77% were founded by an immigrant, or by the child of an immigrant

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
## Freedom of Speech on Campus Depends on Ideology

	Conservative	Liberal
Political ideology of the average faculty member of a department	9%	71%
Likelihood of faculty being "Extremely" or "Very" likely to self-censor in certain campus settings	73%	45%
Likelihood of a new faculty member being a "Very" or "Somewhat Positive" fit within a department:	20%	71%
